

Seaholm Band Boosters Meeting

May 3, 2017

Minutes

Meeting called to order at 6:31pm by Tammy Moore, Band Boosters Vice President

1. Approval of March 8, 2017 minutes.

2. Treasurers Report – Pam Righter, Band Boosters Treasurer

- Auction went very well
- Trumpet was purchased, and saxophone on order, using money already allocated in budget
- Jane O’Shea moved to approve budget, it was seconded, and voted to approve the budget.
- Payments due soon for Adam James and PM Jazz payments coming up soon.
- New Tenor Saxophones are needed for the band. Tim inquired if there would be about \$1,200 in the budget for a new tenor sax. One will be supplied by the district, but was hoping that band boosters could supply another one. Pam Righter suggested using money from the guest soloist line item, but Mr. Cibor would like to hold off on that for now. He plans to discuss obtaining enough funds to purchase 2 from the music department, rather from the boosters. He will update us later.

2. Director’s Report – Tim Cibor

- Upcoming Events/Items:
 - **Spring Concert:** Tuesday, May 9, 2017
 - highlighted by guest conductor, Lynnette Malburg. Alumni of Seaholm and Derby have been invited to celebrate her.
 - 7:30 call time and students to bring garment bag, hanger, and change of clothes and return all pieces at the end of the concert.
 - Flowers for seniors were discussed. Shawna expressed concern that with the rose corsages, the wax comes through and ruins the tuxes. Suggested changing to carnations?? It was determined from Tim, that 50 would be needed to include all seniors, including those in jazz band that weren’t in regular band.
 - 2017-18 Band Leadership and Drum majors to be voted on in 2 weeks.
 - **2017-18 Seaholm Band:** will be the biggest ever with 74+ incoming freshman, 230-40 total.
 - Tim asked if there would be enough uniforms for the increased numbers. Shayne Gordon stated uniforms should be ok for next year’s numbers, as she had

already purchased 7 uniforms this year. She has ordered some smaller sized marching bibs, as well as 3 new drum major hats for next year.

-Tim will not address changing the banquet location for next years increased numbers, as numbers may not sustain over time. Will evaluate next year.

 - Next year's raffle will be on March 23, 2018 and theme is "All that Glitters".
 - Raffle will be changed up slightly for next year, more details to follow next year
